

BALANCED DIGESTIVE NUTRIENTS

Healthy and complete digestion depends almost entirely on the normal acid/base balance in the digestive tract. In the small intestine, the pancreas is responsible for maintaining alkalinity by releasing as much as a litre of bicarbonate fluids during the digestive process. If these bicarbonates are not made available to the pancreas, then the digestion will be incomplete due to ineffective enzyme activity causing putrefaction, toxin accumulations, gas, generalized muscular weakness, and even ulcers.

INDICATORS:

BIOCARB is necessary to improve conditions of intestinal acidity. This is evident with the following conditions:

1. Intestinal rumbling and gas
2. Feeling cold after meals
3. Aversion to raw vegetables and fruits which cause sensations of coldness and sluggish feeling
4. Fruit consumption causes bad smelling gas
5. Undigested vegetables and fibrous foods
6. Gas by afternoon
7. Stomach area can actually feel cold to the touch
8. Loose stools if too much fruit
9. History of ulcers in the stomach or duodenum

DIRECTIONS:

As a dietary supplement, take 1 to 2 capsules a day with meals, or as directed by a physician.

COMBINATIONS:

Enzyme F/S — if the symptoms are aggravated in the stomach by the consumption of starches (rice, grain products, and wheat)

Enzyme Pro — when there is also the presence of joint pain, skin lesions, ingrown hairs, arthritis, and muscle aches

PanPro — can help when there is foul stool odor and gas aggravated by fruit and eating concentrated proteins like nuts, peanut butter, and soy products

DiaChol — when there is persistent diarrhea, soft stools, or celiac disease
